
Good question, we have a very simple answer. An aligner is a clear piece of plastic (BPA free) that's been perfectly molded to fit your teeth. Each month, we'll send you different sets of aligners that will gently straighten your teeth over the course of your treatment plan.

Who creates said treatment plan? Again, very good question. We work with an expansive network of affiliated dental professionals, assigning each person to a provider in their state. Our affiliated provider will prescribe and oversee your treatment, ensuring quality care without wasting your time or money.

Our invisible aligners are also an allowed expense under FSA, HSA and other similar accounts, as they are medical devices that correct mild to moderate orthodontic misalignment. Sorry, had to get a little medical on you there.

Once you purchase your aligners, a series of individual aligners (BPA free) are crafted using 3D printing and high-tech thermoforming (pretty cool science stuff).



4 Aligners are shipped to you

Every month, you'll receive multiple sets of aligners. And your first shipment will contain premium whitening. Each new set gently moves your teeth until they form a smile you'll love.





Retainers

You can purchase a set of retainers for \$99 after checking with your dental professional and completing treatment. You'll wear them at night to help keep your new smile in place. We recommend getting a new set every six months to help keep them fresh.





Things you should know.

How long does treatment take?

It ranges from 3 to 15 months depending on your specific treatment plan from your dental professional, with an average of 6 months.

Is a doctor involved in my treatment?

Yes. One of our licensed dental professionals will digitally assess your smile and prescribe your custom-made aligners.

Why don't I need to go the dental office?

Instead of time-consuming, in-office visits, we check in with you monthly throughout treatment to make sure your new smile is on track. And doctors are standing by to answer any questions you may have about your treatment plan.

How often do I have to wear my aligners?

This varies from 17 to 22 hours every day, depending on your smile journey. You can take them out for eating and drinking.

How long will it take to get my aligners?

Once you place your order, we'll get started right away on creating your invisible aligners. You should expect to receive them in about four weeks. Remember, we custom make every single aligner.

Will my teeth hurt?

It's normal to experience some mild discomfort for the first few days when starting a new set of aligners.

What happens after my treatment is complete?

Your teeth are going to want to slip back into their old habits and places. Retainers are the only way to keep your smile in line and protect the investment you've made.
